

Employability Assistance for Persons with Disabilities - Job Trainer Supports for Persons with Developmental Disabilities

Description

This program is designed to assist people with developmental disabilities obtain employment. Community groups (usually employment corporations), work to help individuals obtain employment. Individuals requiring supports may apply to Human Resources, Labour and Employment for funding.

Eligible Participants

Individuals with developmental disabilities requiring support with accessing employment and performing job duties.

Employment Corporations also provide counseling and other assistance including job placement services for individuals with developmental disabilities.

Job Trainer Supports

Funding may be provided to eligible applicants to provide support and training for individuals with developmental disabilities. The duration and amount of the job trainer support is based on the assessed need of the individual to learn and adjust to performing job duties independently.

How to Apply

Individuals requiring job trainer supports must request an assessment and employment plan through Human Resources, Labour and Employment offices. Organizations such as Employment Corporations may assist an individual with the application process.

The Department of Human Resources, Labour and Employment provides funding to Employment Corporations on behalf of eligible applicants across Newfoundland and Labrador to hire Job Trainers to work with clients requiring this assistance.
