

Employability Assistance for Persons with Disabilities - Training and Employment Supports

Description

This program provides supports to individuals with disabilities and significant disability related challenges to access training and skill development opportunities. It is designed to assist persons with disabilities acquire the skills, experience and support necessary to successfully prepare for, enter or remain in the work force.

Eligible Participants

Persons with disabilities and demonstrated challenges in accessing education and/or employment.

Training and Employment Supports

- employment counselling, assessment and employment planning
- funding to support completion of first post-secondary degree, diploma, or certificate
- funding for technical aids or equipment and other supports to assist individuals access and maintain employment

How to Apply

Individuals wishing to access these services should contact their local Human Resources, Labour and Employment office.

Individuals completing Level III High School or ABE should contact Human Resources, Labour and Employment in January of the year they will be graduating.
