

The Department of Human Resources, Labour and Employment is a partner in Government's Violence Prevention Initiative and is committed to supporting individuals who live in violence.

Emergency Supports for Victims of Violence include:

- transportation to a shelter/transition house or other safe location
- accommodations at a safe location

These types of arrangements may be made directly with the shelters (any time of night or day) or through staff at the Department of Human Resources, Labour and Employment.

Supports for Victims of Violence in receipt of Income Support benefits include:

- continuation of income support benefits based on the individual's financial circumstances
- transportation from one shelter to another for safety reasons
- transportation to move household furniture
- transportation to supportive counseling
- transportation outside the province for safety reasons
- start-up allowance as a contribution towards obtaining furniture, linens, clothing etc. where it is deemed unsafe to return home for these items
- services of the regional liaison social worker

Other Supports for Victims of Violence may include:

- personal allowance for the period of time an individual may be residing at a shelter (this is based on the individual's financial circumstances and is delivered by the Department of Health and Community Services)
