

# Grants to Youth Organizations

## Description

Human Resources, Labour and Employment provides funding to support youth-serving organizations in Newfoundland and Labrador whose focus is on self-reliance, leadership and citizenship development.

## Grants Available

There are two types of grants available:

- **administrative grants** - contributions made to the operations of a youth services organization
- **special project grants** - funding for the provision of a specific service or event to a defined target group

## Eligible Applicants

Applicants will be assessed based on the following criteria:

- purpose of program - to be consistent with the mandate of the Department of Human Resources, Labour and Employment (i.e. youth programming aimed at enhancing the social, career, leadership and participation of youth in community opportunities)
- structure of program - well-defined (i.e. include goals, objectives and methods of service delivery and expected outcomes, governance and accountability)
- ability to address a gap in service in the community
- ability to complement other services

## Client Groups Served

Priority will be given to applicants who:

- serve a broad age group up to age 30
- reach a sufficient number of youth to justify the funding levels to be provided
- have an ability to include youth who may experience challenges to participation

## Organizational Considerations

- structure
- accountability
- program and financial management

## Funding Allocations

The amount of the grant will be based on:

- funding requested
- other funding sources
- number of youth served
- staffing levels
- operating and infrastructure requirements
- types of services provided
- departmental funding available
- historical allocations
