

Provincial Online Tutoring Program

Description

Post-secondary students may earn a tuition voucher as an online tutor throughout the school year. Online tutors provide tutoring to high school students through the IT programs at the Centre for Distance Learning and Innovation (CDLI) at www.cdli.ca. This program is funded by the Department of Human Resources, Labour and Employment.

Eligible Applicants to be Tutors

Post-secondary students can apply to be an online tutor.

Eligible Participants to be Tutored

Students in high school needing tutoring services can access this program through the CDLI guidance counsellor or by visiting www.cdli.ca/tutoring.

Reimbursement

Post-secondary students will be paid at the minimum wage level with a tuition voucher at the end of the program. This voucher can be used at any recognized post-secondary institution.
