

Tutoring Work Experience Program (TWEP)

Description

Post-secondary students may earn a tuition voucher plus a weekly stipend by tutoring high school students in person who are preparing for year-end exams or they may also tutor online through the IT programs at the Centre for Distance, Learning and Innovation (CDLI). This program is funded by the Department of Human Resources, Labour and Employment.

Eligible Applicants to be Tutors

Post-secondary students who are interested in tutoring in the high school environment may apply to be TWEP tutors.

Eligible Participants to be Tutored

Students at the high school level needing tutoring services may access this program.

Compensation

Post-secondary students who are TWEP tutors will be paid equivalent to the minimum wage composed of a weekly stipend as well as a tuition voucher at the end of the program to be used at any recognized post-secondary institution.

How to Apply

High school students in need of tutoring may contact their school guidance counsellor or principal or they may access online tutoring at www.cdli.ca/tutoring.

Post-secondary students interested in being TWEP tutors in a high school may apply through the school guidance counsellor or principal.
